To Whom It May Concern,

Please note that all students registered in the Bachelor of (Education); Major in Education in Global Contexts program are required to complete a mandatory Internship course during the Winter or Summer term of their second academic year. The Internship course constitutes an integral and essential part of their program requirements and requires a minimum of 150 hours of work with an approved national or international host institution or organization and is generally 12 weeks in duration.

We are requesting that a co-op work permit be given to the applicant, as per their admission letter or letter of enrolment, in order for them to complete their Internship course
